

EEPIS of Indonesia going for 9th straight win!!



The Indonesia Robot Contest 2010 was held at the UMM Dome in Malang in Indonesia on 19 and 20 June. The venue was filled with over 5,000 audience mostly student supporters from participating universities.

Participants in the domestic contest went through 3 phrases of screening. Indonesia Robot Contest Committee has received 320 project proposals for document screening in January 2010.

Then students built robots for video screening at the end of April. As a result of screening by the Committee, 80 teams were selected for 5 regional contests respectively held in Bangka Belitung Island, Bandung, Yogyakarta, Malang and Manado on every weekend of May.

As a result of regional contest, 4 best teams from each region, total of 20 teams proceeded to the finals in June.

This year, team 'Mio-rEi' of **Electronic Engineering Polytechnic Institute of Surabaya (EEPIS)** reached to the top of Indonesia Robocon. This is the 9th straight win for EEPIS, meaning they have been defending champion title since 2002. The 1st runner-up was Institut Teknologi Sepuluh Nopember from Surabaya.

Various media covered story on this event and the news of EEPIS's win was aired on TV and radio nationwide.

TVRI, the broadcaster in charge will broadcast 2 special programmes featuring domestic contest, 30-min. each starting at 17:30 (Indonesia time) on Sunday 27 June and 4 July 2010.
