Technical Developments during the past year: System upgrades/changes to practices for improved quality/efficiency NBT-Thailand on behalf of The Government Public Relations Department (PRD) have 12 television stations (1 Nationwide station and 11 local stations preparing to merge 11 local TV to 4 regional TV station) and then NBT-Thailand licensed for a public television channel for 4 channels of 4 regional TV station, consisting of NBT-North, NBT-Northeast, NBT-South and NBT-Central by using the same channel number "11" 2020 - 2021, 700 MHz band of digital TV was released frequency spectrum from 510 - 790 MHz to 470 – 694 MHz for International Mobile Telecommunication : IMT (4G and 5G) In 2021, Replacement and upgrades all of the radio equipment for 8 radio frequencies In 2022, Replacement and upgrades all of the radio equipment for 10 radio frequencies is in progress. New Services/new projects initiated • Currently, NBT-Thailand is in the process of defining TOR for the establishment of a new facility. The new building will serve all types of media.
