

Field Trip: Semenggoh Wildlife Centre

This is a rare opportunity to see one of the world's endangered species – the orangutan. Orangutans are the largest arboreal mammal, spending most of their time in trees. These great apes share 97 percent of our DNA and are highly intelligent. The name orangutan means "man of the forest" in the Malay language.

This tour provides an opportunity to observe how orangutans are being rehabilitated and taught to fend for themselves before being released into the wild. The Semenggoh Wildlife Centre is the only one of its kind in Sarawak and is dedicated to helping protect Malaysia's biodiversity.

We will drive 30 minutes from Kuching and walk 1.6 kilometres through lush tropical rainforest. This field trip will be a highlight of your visit to Sarawak!
