Instituting ABU Young Engineers' Broadcasting Award

Considering

- 1. that the Engineering Awards and its guidelines were recently reviewed by the select Task Group to evaluate its scope and relevance within the current industry;
- 2. that the existing Engineering Awards, within its scope mostly targets more experienced and veteran broadcast engineers;
- 3. that no such avenues exist within the current awards to recognise and encourage innovative and creative contributions made by young engineers,

Recognising

- 1. that other awards instituted to recognise outstanding contributions by broadcast engineers has made an impact in the said purpose;
- 2. that a lack of such an award was noted by the Engineering Awards review task group and was noted among its recommendations;

The ABU Technical Committee Decides

- 1. To institute the ABU Young Engineers' Broadcasting Award to recognise outstanding contributions made by young engineers within the ABU broadcasting member organisations in the region.
- 2. That the secretariat will develop a set of appropriate guidelines and selection modality for this award and present it to the next mid-year meeting of the Technical Bureau for their approval.
- 3. That the ABU Young Engineers' Broadcasting Award be included as part of the annual awards in 2023.
