

REGIONAL WORKSHOP ON DRM DIGITAL RADIO IMPLEMENTATION AND ROLLOUT

The DRM Digital Radio Implementation and Rollout Workshop is jointly organised by the Asia-Pacific Broadcasting Union and the Digital Radio Mondiale (DRM) Consortium. The workshop will take place from 9-10 October 2019 in Kuala Lumpur at the Holiday Inn Express Kuala Lumpur Hotel.

The workshop aims to provide broadcasters, regulators, policy makers, governments and other stakeholders with a clear understanding of the DRM digital radio broadcasting services, its technology and features, planning methods, step-by-step implementation examples and the various solutions and strategies available for anyone planning to move from analogue to a digital radio system from planning to full-scale countrywide rollout.
