

# INFORMATION NOTE for delegates of the 59<sup>th</sup> ABU General Assembly and Associated Meetings

# 1. Travelling to India

- India requires all travellers to complete a COVID-19 declaration form online, before travel to India.
  Please go to the <u>Air Suvidha portal</u>. You will be required to submit details of your COVID-19 vaccinations or the details of a negative RT-PCR test.
- If you are travelling to India via another country, please make sure you comply with their requirements, especially if you are going through immigration in the transit country. People going through Singapore immigration need to complete a form <u>ICA | SG Arrival Card</u> three days before departure.

### 2. Arrival in New Delhi

On arrival to New Delhi airport, all delegates are advised to assemble near VIP gate next to Immigration area. There will be personnel at the airport to assist delegates to proceed with the immigration procedure.

#### 3. Airport/Hotels transfer

There will be Prasar Bharati colleagues with ABU Delegates placard waiting at the Arrivals Hall after customs. Prasar Bharati colleagues will organise transport to your respective hotel for those who are booked at the designated GA hotels Pullman, Novotel and IBIS.

#### 4. The Venue, Hotels

The main venue of the General Assembly and Associated Meetings is the Pullman Hotel. Novotel Hotel is interconnected the Pullman Hotel, you can easily walk between them using the designated pathway. IBIS Hotel is about 5 minutes walking distance from the Pullman Hotel.

Transportation will be provided from the Pullman Hotel to the venues of TV Song Festival, Excursion and the NHK Reception venue, on the days for those functions. The ABU Prizes ceremony will be held in the Pullman Hotel.

# 5. GA Registration Desk

The GA Registration Desk is located before the entrance of the Peacock Ballroom of the Pullman Hotel ground floor. Upon arrival the host will provide you with information of the opening hours of the Registration Desk. Please bring your passport/IC for identification when you come to register. The host is planning to use QR code system for the registration where you may be asked to provide your personal information.

#### 6. Currency Exchange

The local currency is Indian Rupee (INR), you can exchange money from the bank, money changers, and at the airport. These 7 currencies; USD, AUD, BHD, CAD, CNY DKK and GBP are available for exchange. The exchange rate is around 1 USD = 81.62 INR (as of this print), the rates may vary so please confirm before you make the change.

## 7. Electricity and Plugs

Electricity in India uses the power plugs and sockets are of type C, D and M. The standard voltage is 230 V and the standard frequency is 50 Hz. It is advisable to carry power adaptors/converters as required.




### 8. Weather in New Delhi in November

The average temperature in New Delhi in November for a typical day ranges from a high of 28°C (83°F) and a low of 13°C (55°F). Some would describe it as mildly cool. In New Delhi in November, there's a 3% chance of rain on an average day.

### 9. Exploring the city

Public transport in New Delhi includes the Delhi Metro, the Delhi Transport Corporation (DTC) bus system, auto-rickshaws, cycle-rickshaws and taxis. Other means of transit include suburban railways, inter-state bus services and private taxis which can be rented for various purposes.

For affordable taxi rides you can download Ola cab app which is most popular although Uber can also be used.
