# **IPLC AWARDS**

## **Awards Rules**

### **Article 1 OBJECTIVE**

To showcase how Intellectual Property law's theoretical basis can revolutionise the ABU members' workplace through innovative practical implementation methodologies or something the members did for the development or to strengthen IPR's in their countries or organisations.

The Award is to recognize the most impressive presentation in implying "Building Respect for IP" by the ABU member. The Awards shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the terms of the Awards Rules.

### **Article 2 SUBMISSION**

2.1 The submission must be either a 7-minutes presentation or a write up containing a maximum of 2,000 words.

2.2 The teams must showcase "Building Respect for IP" through its practical implementation in innovative ways in the workplace or in their countries spearheaded by their team.

### **Article 3 ELIGIBILITY**

3.1 All ABU members and partners who are stakeholders in Broadcasting /IP are eligible to take part in the Awards. The Chair of the ABU- IPLC and member/s from his/her jurisdiction are not eligible.

3.2 All entries for the Awards must be free from any political propaganda and/or commercial advertising or promotion.

### **Article 4 JUDGING**

4.1 The ABU Secretariat at its discretion shall appoint the judges and the judges appointed shall comprise of an international independent panel of judges comprising of experts from varying jurisdictions. The ABU Legal Division shall assist the judges and administer the whole process of judging.

4.2 The judgement will be final and conclusive where the participant is deemed to accept that there shall be no appeal or dispute raised on the judgement made by the judges.

### **Article 5 AWARD**

5.1 The winning team and runner-up will be awarded. They will be entitled to a prestigious trophy, and recognition – with press/ publicity given to its team members and their findings/ recommendations as demonstrated through their presentations.

5.2 For the winning team, accommodation will be arranged by the ABU / Host.
